



## Newspaper 2.0

How do you keep up to date? If you're like us, you do not have a newspaper subscription, and use news website to stay posted instead.

One way to browse for news is to use Reddit<sup>1</sup> or similar web-sites, where links to news of all sorts are published. Reddit submissions are categorized in subreddits (communities interested in a particular topic). One typically selects one or more subreddit to browse, and gets presented the currently highest scoring content. However, since a subreddits' topic is typically quite coarse, often there are only a handful of links per subreddit that are interesting to you.

We want to re-think the Reddit experience. Instead of you choosing the subreddits to browse, we want to select for you the most interesting posts based on your personal taste.

### Goals

In this thesis, we want you to develop an Android app for Reddit that is fun and visually appealing. The app should learn about the user's taste by gathering usage feedback, and only present the parts of Reddit that match those preferences. You have the opportunity to implement your own ideas that would make *your* Reddit browsing experience more enjoyable.

### Requirements

- Good Java Programming skills.
- Ability to work independently on the topic.
